

## Bursting with achievement at Ware Assessment Centre!

On June 22<sup>nd</sup> the Ware Assessment Centre (WAC), part of the Department of Care & Early Years at Hertford Regional College, held an award presentation to celebrate the achievement of 351 students, who have completed their NVQ or VQ awards since February.

The achievement rate of candidates enrolled with the Ware Assessment Centre has been so high that the award presentation was the second of three planned for 2006. The first award presentation, which took place earlier this year, was combined with the outstanding news and formal recognition that the centre had achieved the status 'Centre of Vocational Excellence' (CoVE).

When asked about the year on year growth and the outstanding accomplishments of WAC since its inception, Initiative Manager, Gill Forrest said "The success of the Ware Assessment Centre is due to the hard work of the students and the commitment of a dedicated staff team."
